

The Lucky Penny Diner

Thanks for downloading the prototype for “The Lucky Penny Diner,” a 2-4 player game in which everyone competes to earn tips from a common pool of guests at a 24-hour diner.

To play you will need to print and cut the 54 cards from the included .pdfs (see below for instructions). You will also need 16 small counters. Pennies work best, but any other coin or small object is fine. Please consult the rules.pdf for more info.

Printing instructions:

In order to play you will need to print out the file “Print-Front_v1.3.pdf.” You may also choose to print out “Print-Back_v1.3.pdf,” although this is not absolutely necessary if you want to conserve paper and ink. The one exception is the time card, which must have both sides printed. If you don’t want to print any of the other card backs, you can choose to print just page 1 of the “Print-Back_v1.3.pdf.”

If you are printing on both sides of the paper, ensure you flip the pages the long way after printing the first side to ensure that everything lines up correctly. Alternatively, you can print on separate pieces of paper and, after cutting, insert the fronts and backs into card sleeves with a normal playing card sandwiched in the middle to provide stiffness.
